NOTICE OF REFERRAL FOR A HEARING

Pursuant to section 13 of Regulation 9-1, adopted by Council under the *Chartered Professional Accountants of Ontario Act, 2017*, and the By-law governing the Chartered Professional Accountants of Ontario (“CPA Ontario”), I hereby request the Admission and Registration Committee to convene an oral hearing in respect of this application.

THE GROUNDS FOR THE REQUEST ARE:

1. The Applicant applied for registration with the CPA Ontario on August 29, 2019. Having reviewed the application for registration, I am not satisfied that the Applicant has provided evidence of good character as required under s.13 of Regulation 9-1.
2. The particulars are as follows:
 - a. In [REDACTED] application for registration, the Applicant answered “yes” to the question, “Have you ever been found guilty of a criminal offence or other similar offence for which a pardon has not been granted or are there any other charges pending against you”?
 - b. The questionnaire the Applicant submitted with [REDACTED] application indicates that [REDACTED] was charged with violating s. 253(1)(b) of the *Criminal Code*, by operating a motor vehicle after having consumed alcohol in such a quantity that his blood alcohol concentration exceeded 80 mg of alcohol per 100 mL of blood.
 - c. The incident occurred on August 2, 2016. The Applicant entered a guilty plea on August 16, 2016.
 - d. In pleading guilty, the Applicant acknowledged [REDACTED] had operated a motor vehicle while [REDACTED] blood alcohol concentration was above the legal limit. The results of [REDACTED] two breath samples were 110 and 100 mg of alcohol per 100 mL of blood.
 - e. The Applicant was sentenced on August 16, 2016, with the following conditions:
 - i. Fine of \$1,000 to be paid within 90 days, plus a victim fine surcharge; and

- ii. 12-month driving prohibition, to be reduced to 3 months if the Applicant qualified for the interlock program.
- 3. I have determined that the Applicant otherwise meets all the criteria for registration.
