The Professional Conduct Committee of CPA Ontario hereby makes the following Allegation of professional misconduct against Jules Mathieu, a suspended member of CPA Ontario:

- THAT the said Jules Mathieu, in or about October 12, 2021 through December 1, 2021, failed to co-operate with the regulatory process of CPA Ontario, contrary to Rule 104.2 of the CPA Code of Professional Conduct (Code), in that:
 - a. He failed to promptly reply in writing to CPA Ontario communications to which a written reply is specifically required, namely the correspondence of Ms. Jennifer Carriere, CPA, CA, Standards Enforcement (SE) Officer (Carriere), dated September 21, 2021, sent to his preferred email address, follow up voice mail messages of Ms. Elizabeth Archer, SE Co-ordinator (Archer) left on his preferred telephone numbers on September 21, 2021, and, registered mail of the same correspondence, that was delivered to and signed for by J. Mathieu on October 6, 2021.
 - b. He failed to promptly reply in writing to CPA Ontario communications to which a written reply is specifically required, namely the correspondence of Carriere, dated October 20, 2021 sent to his preferred email address and via registered mail, and follow up voice mail messages of Archer left on his preferred telephone numbers on October 20, 2021.
