DECISION AND ORDER MADE MAY 13, 2022

DECISION

The Allegation that Jules Mathieu has breached Rule 104.2 of the CPA Ontario Code of Professional Conduct is established, and he has committed professional misconduct.

<u>ORDER</u>

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Jules Mathieu shall cooperate with the Professional Conduct Committee by fully responding to the correspondence of the Chartered Professional Accountants of Ontario ("CPA Ontario"), dated September 21, 2021, and October 20, 2021, from Jennifer Carrier by June 13, 2022;
- 2. Jules Mathieu shall pay a fine of \$5,000 to CPA Ontario by December 30, 2023;
- 3. Jules Mathieu shall be reprimanded in writing by the Chair of the hearing;
- 4. Notice of this Decision and Order, disclosing Jules Mathieu's name, is to be given in the form and manner determined by the Discipline Committee:
 - (a) to all members of CPA Ontario:
 - (b) to all provincial bodies;

and shall be made available to the public;

5. In the event Jules Mathieu fails to comply with any of the terms of this Order, his membership in CPA Ontario shall be revoked, and notice of the revocation, disclosing his name, shall be given in the manner specified above, and in a newspaper distributed in the geographic area of his practice. All costs associated with this publication shall be borne

by Jules Mathieu and shall be in addition to any other costs ordered by the Panel.

AND THAT:

6. Jules Mathieu shall pay costs of \$3,200.00 to CPA Ontario on or before December 30, 2023.
