DECISION

The Panel was satisfied that Allegations 1(b), 1(d), 2, 3(a), 3(b), 3(c), 4(a) and 4(b) were proven and constituted breaches of Rules 104, 206.1 and 218 of the CPA Ontario Code of Professional Conduct. The Panel determined that, having breached these Rules, Jack Cayne committed professional misconduct.

The Panel concluded that Allegation 1(c) was not proven.

<u>ORDER</u>

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Panel remains seized of the issue of sanction in this matter;
