#### **DECISION AND ORDER MADE JUNE 15, 2023**

#### **DECISION**

The Allegation that Michael J. lannone has breached Rule 104.2 of the CPA Ontario Code of Professional Conduct is established, and he has committed professional misconduct.

### **ORDER**

#### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Michael J. Iannone shall pay a fine of \$5,000 to the Chartered Professional Accountants of Ontario ("CPA Ontario") by July 15, 2023;
- 2. Michael J. lannone shall be reprimanded in writing by the Chair of the hearing;
- 3. Michael J. Iannone shall cooperate with the regulatory process of CPA Ontario by July 15, 2023, by responding to the letters from Eric Bunn dated September 19, 2022, October 18, 2022, and November 14, 2022;
- 4. Notice of this Decision and Order, disclosing Michael J. lannone's name, is to be given in the form and manner determined by the Discipline Committee:
  - (a) to all members of CPA Ontario;
  - (b) to all provincial bodies;

and shall be made available to the public.

5. In the event that Michael J. lannone fails to comply with the terms of this Order, his membership in CPA Ontario shall be suspended until such time as he does comply, provided that he complies within 30 days from the date of his suspension. In the event he does not comply within the 30-day period, his membership in CPA Ontario shall be

revoked, and notice of the revocation, disclosing his name, shall be given in the manner specified above, and in the Globe and Mail newspaper edition circulated in Toronto, the geographic area of his practice. All costs associated with this publication shall be borne by Michael J. lannone and shall be in addition to any other costs ordered by the Panel.

## AND THAT:

6. Michael J. lannone shall pay costs of \$2,927.50 to CPA Ontario by July 15, 2023.
