DECISION AND ORDER MADE SEPTEMBER 6, 2023

DECISION

The Allegation that Mihonron M. Camara has breached Rule 104.2 of the CPA Ontario Code of Professional Conduct is established, and he has committed professional misconduct.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Mihonron M. Camara shall pay a fine of \$10,000 to CPA Ontario by October 10, 2023;
- 2. Mihonron M. Camara shall be reprimanded in writing by the Chair of the hearing;
- 3. Mihonron M. Camara shall cooperate with the regulatory process of CPA Ontario by producing documentation requested by Ian Wintrip, CPA, CA ("Investigator") as set out in the Investigator's email dated April 11, 2023, and attending an interview with the Investigator by October 10, 2023;
- 4. Notice of this Decision and Order, disclosing Mihonron M. Camara's name, is to be given in the form and manner determined by the Discipline Committee:
 - (a) to all members of CPA Ontario;
 - (b) to all provincial bodies;

and shall be made available to the public;

5. In the event that Mihonron M. Camara fails to comply with the terms of this Order by October 10, 2023, his membership in CPA Ontario shall be revoked, and notice of the revocation, disclosing his name, shall be given in the manner specified above, and in the

Globe and Mail. All costs associated with this publication shall be borne by Mihonron M. Camara and shall be in addition to any other costs ordered by the Panel.

AND THAT:

6. Mihonron M. Camara shall pay costs of \$10,900 to CPA Ontario by October 10, 2023.
